Service	Cost	
Full day (Up to 9 hours) Example: 7:30am – 16:30pm; you choose if we have availability. This includes breakfast, lunch, snacks, activities, and resources. However, two course evening meal is extra.	£65	
Half day (Up to 4.5 hours) Example: 7:30am – 12noon This includes snack, activities, and resources. Depending on the times chosen, breakfast and/or lunch is included. However, a two course evening meal is charged extra if your child is in over these times.	£48	
Full week (9 hours per day everyday) This includes breakfast, lunch, snacks, activities, and resources per day. However, two course evening meal is extra per day.	£275	
Hourly rate (if you require extra childcare)	£15	
Afterschool Club (Up to 2.5 hours) Staff member collects from school at 3pm and latest you can collect your child is 5:30pm. This includes collection from school, snack and two course evening meal.	£38	
Weekly Consumables Fee (For children who are in receipt of Government Funding) This includes but is not limited to: topic resources and equipment, toothbrush, wipes, tissues, hand towels, online journal, outings and trips, plates and cutlery, water bottles, cups, sleep mats, bibs, nappy sacks, flannels, toilet paper, waterproofs). Meals and snacks are charged separately, in line with Government guidance.	For 15 hours funding £2.50	For 30 hours funding £5
Snack (nutritional, balanced snack, based on a two weekly varied menu) Served am/pm	For children of all ages 50p	
Lunch (nutritional, balanced single course meal, based on a two weekly varied menu)	For a child under 2 years £2.75	For a child over 2 years £3
Evening Meal (nutritional, balanced two course meal including main course and dessert, based on a two weekly varied menu)	For a child under 2 years £3	For a child over 2 years £3.50

Government Funding Options Available for parents:

- ✓ Tax Free childcare - Up to £2000.00 per child per year.
- ✓ 2-Year-olds - 15 hours funded childcare per week for families receiving some forms of support.
- ✓ 2-Year-olds - 15 hours funded childcare per week for eligible working families.
- ✓ 9 months upwards - 15 hours funded childcare per week for eligible working families.
- ✓ 3- & 4-year-olds - 30 hours funded childcare per week for eligible working families.
- ✓ (From September 2025) 9 months to school age - 30 hours funded childcare per week for eligible working families.
